Here's a great way for your school to get to the Aquarium: ride Metro-North Railroad!

Get off at the South Norwalk station and The Maritime Aquarium is just a short four-block walk away.

Here's how. Go to: www.mta.info. Go to the Metro-North Railroad home page, select [Travel](#), go to [Group Travel](#), scroll to bottom of page and click [Reserve Now](#). To receive the group-rate discount, tickets must be purchased at least 7 to 10 business days prior to travel.

from Mamaroneck:

\$2.25 per youth (18 & under)
