## Long Island Sound Treasure Chest

The Long Island Sound Treasure Chest is a trunk that's overflowing with materials designed for learning about the Sound and its watershed. Included are natural artifacts, posters, photographs, published curricula, children's books, craft ideas, videos, a teacher's guide and videotaped "workshop."

Educators can use the Treasure Chest's materials any way they choose, and are encouraged to share its resources among grade levels and classes.

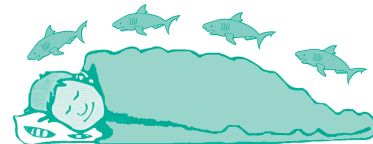
The Treasure Chest is leased for three-week periods, with an option to extend its stay at your school. The Aquarium arranges for UPS drop-off and pick-up at your facility.

Your group can share the Aquarium with other students (240 maximum total), from 6 p.m. to 10 a.m. Groups of more than 200 get the Aquarium to themselves. Groups of less than 200 are paired with other groups. Minimum is 80 participants. Cost is \$56 per person.



Activities include a light supper, guided tour, relay games, snack, crafts, breakfast, a private seal feeding and a movie from our IMAX library. Special topics can be featured during guided tours for work toward school projects or Scout badges.
