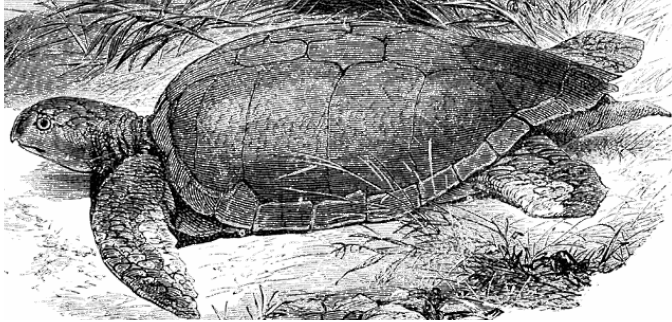


Trail Critters

The Green Turtle



1. Go to the SEA TURTLE EXHIBIT.
2. Stand behind the life-size shell cutout of the green turtle.
3. Is the green turtle larger or smaller than the loggerhead?
4. Read the FACT or FICTION board.
5. Complete the back of this card.

Fact or Fiction

After you find your Critter, read its FACT or FICTION board. Then circle FACT or FICTION below.

- FACT FICTION A female sea turtle will only dig one nest to lay her eggs.
