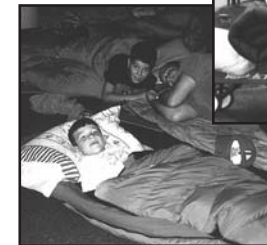

Your group can enjoy The Aquarium and all it has to offer from 6 p.m. to 10 a.m.

That's right! Your group will share The Maritime Aquarium with up to 240 other campers and take part in a wide range of activities, including a private screening of an IMAX movie. They'll have fish 'n' ships for company as they sleep.

Minimum: 80 participants

Maximum: 240 participants

Cost: \$56 per person

Includes: light supper, a guided tour, snack, IMAX film, breakfast, and program materials.

To secure your space and date, \$150 is due within 10 working days of the initial reservation. Four months prior to your scheduled program date, a reservation for a guaranteed minimum number of attendees is due along with 50% of the total remaining balance. Additional campers can be added to your group later if space is available. However, due to the lead time required for program staffing and ordering supplies, we cannot adjust your attendance numbers down after you guarantee your group size. Three weeks prior to your overnight date, the remainder of your payment is due. This advance payment schedule allows everyone – campers and leaders alike – to enjoy the overnight program hassle free from check-in time to departure!

Acceptable forms of payment are:
check, MasterCard, Visa, AMEX, or cash.

PLEASE BE AWARE that the City of Norwalk's Maritime Garage charges a \$3 fee from 5 PM to noon the following day.
